

# **2018 Wenzhou Medical University Confucius Institute**

## **Scholarship (CIS) Application Procedure**

In order to support development of Confucius Institutes, facilitate Chinese language promotion and Chinese cultural transmission in the world, cultivate qualified Chinese language teachers and talented students of Chinese language, Confucius Institute Headquarters (Hanban) (hereinafter referred to as Hanban) launches the “Confucius Institute Scholarships” program for providing sponsorship to students, scholars and Chinese language teachers of other countries for pursuing a study in relevant universities in China (hereinafter referred to as “host institutions”).

### **I Overview of Wenzhou Medical University**

Wenzhou is an important port city in southeast coastline of China, located in the joint zone of the Yangtze River Delta and Pearl River Delta, two of the most important economic zones in China. The land area is about 12,065 square km. Wenzhou has a population of 9.2 million, the largest number in Zhejiang Province. Wenzhou Medical University (WMU) is a key institution of higher learning under the direct administration of Zhejiang Provincial Government. It can trace its origin to the former Zhejiang Specialized Medical School established in 1912. WMU recruits domestic students from the whole country. Top 3.7% students in Zhejiang Province (according to their national entrance exam scores) can be qualified for enrollment in Clinical Medicine, Stomatology, Ophthalmology and Optometry programs. Over 1000 international students from 60 countries are studying at WMU currently. We have built two overseas Confucius institutes, one was cooperated with Burapha University, Thailand in 2006. Another one was cooperated with the State University of New York College of Optometry in 2010.

## II Sponsoring Target

1. Non-Chinese citizens
2. In good Physical and mental condition, well performed both academically and behaviorally
3. Dedicated to work on Chinese language education, teaching or international promotion of Chinese language.
4. 18-35 years old (by September 1st, 2018). Applicants who are currently working as Chinese language teachers shall not exceed the age limit of 45. Undergraduate students shall not exceed the age limit of 25).

## III Category & Admission Requirements

Category	Program	Requirements	Sponsoring Duration
1-Academic Year Student	Chinese Language	HSK Level-3 180	11 months (register in Sep. 2018) Applicants who are already studying in China are not accepted
1-Semester Student	Traditional Chinese Medicine	HSK	5 months (register in Sep. 2018 or Mar. 2019) Students who have X1 or X2 visas are not accepted
4-Week Student	Traditional Chinese Medicine	HSK	4 weeks (register in Jul. 2018 or Dec. 2018)

## IV Scholarship

The scholarship covers tuition fee, accommodation fee, monthly living allowance (except four weeks students) and comprehensive insurance for foreign students studying in China. The amount of living allowance is 2500 yuan per month for undergraduate students, one-academic-year students and one-semester students.

Confucius Institute students should register on time according to the admission notice, otherwise, the scholarship will be cancelled. Students who register before September 15 (including September 15) can get the whole month living allowance, and students who register after September 15 can only get half of the living allowance for this month.

## V Application Procedure

Online registration will be available from March 1, 2018 on the Confucius Institute Scholarship website (<http://cis.chinese.cn>). Please log on to find recommendation institutions and host institutions, submit application documents online, track the application progress, feedback of review and admission results. Scholarship winners shall confirm with the host institutions to go through the procedures of studying in China, print out CIS certificate online. The scholarship is valid upon registration. Please register at host institutions at the designated date and time

### Deadline

1. Apr. 20<sup>th</sup> (For students register in Jul.)
2. Jun. 20<sup>th</sup> (For students register in Sep.)
3. Sep. 20<sup>th</sup> (For students register in Dec.)
4. Dec. 20<sup>th</sup> (For students register in Mar., 2019)

## VI Disclaimer

1. Incomplete or unqualified applications will not be processed.

2. Applicants will be disqualified from application in case of fraudulent application materials or application materials are completed and submitted by someone else.
3. Scholarship winners who cannot register with the host institutions on time should inform the host institution about the reasons in written form within 15 days before the admission date. For those who do not register as requested without reason, the scholarship will be canceled.
4. Scholarship will be canceled for those who do not pass the admission physical examination, drop out, or take schooling suspension during the study.
