

PRE-REGISTRATION OF STUDENTS ON POSTGRADUATE RESEARCH DEGREE PROGRAMMES (ACADEMIC YEAR 2021/2022)

INFORMATION AND INSTRUCTIONS TO APPLICANTS

[Mauritian Applicants]

1. GENERAL

1.1 Prior to the submission of applications to the Admissions and Student Records Office, prospective **MPhil, MPhil/PhD** and **PhD** applicants may opt to pre-register for the MPhil, MPhil/PhD and PhD programmes by submitting a pre-registration form online to the Admissions and Student Records Office at http://apply.uom.ac.mu/application. Applicants may contact academic staff when choosing their research theme.

Pre-registration for **MA by Research/MSc by Applied Research** is **compulsory** prior to the submission of applications as per above Online Application link.

During the pre-registration period, the candidate will be given access to the UoM Library and to online databases such as Science Direct and Emerald and will have to regularly meet his/her Supervisor(s), so as to prepare a proper Research proposal (consult the "Guidelines for research proposals by prospective applicants for postgraduate research studies").

1.2 Before filling the Pre-registration Form, applicants are advised to read carefully the "MPhil/PhD Regulations 2021/2022" or the Regulations on MA by Research/MSc by Research available on the University of Mauritius website at the following addresses:

1.3 Applicants should submit Pre-registration Form **through the potential Supervisor(s)** in duplicate together with two photocopies of their birth, educational and professional certificates. Married women should also submit a copy of their marriage certificate. Original certificates should <u>NOT</u> be submitted at the time of application for pre-registration but should be produced at pre-registration in case the applicant is selected. <u>Please note that the photocopies of certificates submitted will not be returned.</u>

2. ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

(a) Admission to MPhil, MPhil/PhD

At least a Second Class Honours degree in the relevant field or equivalent

(b) Admission to PhD

There are two categories of candidates for admission:

- (i) Students who are already registered for an MPhil programme at the University of Mauritius may request an upgrade.
- (ii) Students may already have an MPhil research degree or equivalent in the relevant field.

(c) Admission to MA by Research/MSc by Applied Research

At least a Second Class degree from a recognized University, GPA not less than 2.50, or alternative qualifications acceptable to the University of Mauritius.

3. DURATION REQUIREMENTS

The pre-registration period is up to two (2) months.

4. FEE FOR PRE-REGISTRATION

There is no fee payable at the time of application for the pre-registration. However, upon pre-registration, successful applicants must pay a pre-registration fee of Rs2,000.

5. HOW TO APPLY

Application is open throughout the Academic Year.

6. SUBMISSION OF PRE-REGISTRATION FORM

Applicants should send a copy of their signed Pre-registration Form together with their qualifications and a signed letter from the potential supervisor(s) by email: applicationsubmission@uom.ac.mu

- (a) Applications not submitted on prescribed forms will not be considered.
- (b) Documents submitted will not be returned to applicants.
- (c) Candidates will be required to pay the pre-registration fee upon receipt of a pre-registration letter from the University.
