EXTERNAL EXAMINING OF UNDERGRADUATE AND POSTGRADUATE TAUGHT DEGREE PROGRAMMES

2. Roles of an External Examiner

- 2.1 The primary roles of an External Examiner are
 - (a) to assist the University in ensuring that degrees awarded by the University meet international standards; and
 - (b) to assist the University in ensuring that its assessment is valid and the procedures and arrangements for assessment, examination and determination of awards are sound and are conducted rigorously, fairly, reliably and consistently.
- 2.2 The External Examiner is responsible to the Senate of the University.
