STUDENT EXCHANGE MOBILITY TO CANKIRI KARATEKIN UNIVERSITY ACADEMIC YEAR 2024/2025

Cankiri Karatekin University (CAKU), Turkey, has called for nominations for exchange of students from the UoM for Spring term 2024/2025, academic year starting from 24 February 2025 to 13 June 2025.

Mobility dates: 24.02.2025 – 13.06.2025 (Spring term) (110 days in total)

Nominees are required to be in Turkey one (1) week before mobility and return one (1) week after mobility.

Description of the Activity

- Activity Period: Minimum 3 months (except for force-majeure) maximum 12 months for study. For traineeship activity, minimum activity period is 2 months.
- Students are supposed to plan full-time activity, which is equal to 30 ECTS per semester.
- There should be no interruption other than force-majeure conditions. (If the beneficiary leaves host country for more than 7 days during mobility period, it is defined as interruption and this period is not funded.)
- Beneficiary could participate to the programme total of 12 months in one cycle. However, there will be cut back on final score during evaluation of the selection process of the second application (an indicator in evaluation formula).

Who can apply?

- (a) <u>Undergraduate students</u>
 - Students of the BSc (Hons) Mathematics and BSc (Hons) Economics who are currently in Year 2.
- (b) Postgraduate students who are currently in Year 2 Semester I in this academic year 2024/2025 as per the list below:
 - MA Political Science and International Relations
 - MSc Economics
 - MSc Biology
 - MSc Mathematics
 - MA Business
 - MA Art and Design

Students should ensure that they will be able to enrol for all selected modules at Cankiri Karatekin University equivalent to those modules to be offered at UoM for the next Semester failing which they will have to extend their studies at UoM by 1-2 additional semesters. They are therefore strongly advised to first discuss with their Lecturers/Programme Co-ordinators regarding equivalence of modules (which are available on the link provided above regarding "Course Catalogue").

These modules offered by the overseas University will be counted towards the total number of credits required for graduating at UoM.

Evaluation Criteria + Minimum conditions for application

- 1.(a) Undergraduate students who are considering to apply for Erasmus programme should have completed their 1st year at the University and have at least a **GPA of 2.20**.
 - (b) Postgraduate students who are considering to apply for Erasmus programme should have completed their 1st year at the University and have at least a **GPA of 2.50**.
- 2. Students will be selected on the basis of their GPA and CPA, respectively.

Three(3) UoM Students will be selected: two(2) Undergraduate and one(1) Postgraduate.

Grant: 800 Euro per month + travel cost according to distance band.

70% of the grant will be paid within 2 weeks after signing the grant contract. The remaining 30% of the grant will be paid after the completion of the activity and the documents to be submitted.

In order to be considered for nomination by the University of Mauritius, the following details/documents should reach the Office of your respective Dean of Faculty/Registrar of MGI by Friday 04 October 2024 (before noon) at latest:

- 1. Name of Programme applying for, your email address and your mobile number.
- 2. A copy of the Student's <u>latest</u> Transcript.
- 3. A testimonial certifying that you are a registered student at the Faculty/MGI.
