In this Professional Development Programme (PDP), participants will explore the fundamental principles of financial management. Topics include understanding and interpreting a company's financial statements, the time value of money and its role in evaluating the economic viability of different projects, and the annual capital budgeting process every company performs when selecting which projects to fund. In addition, students will cover some highly practical topics, such as determining product costs, preparing a statement of cash flows and establishing operating annual budget statements.
