The Swimming (lifeguard) should have a valid lifeguard certificate and be able to deliver, as and when required, coaching sessions on the same basis as the Swimming (Coach).

Qualifications Required

- A. Cambridge School Certificate
- **B.** Level 1 of the specific part of the Brevet D'Etat de Cadre Sportif (BECS) in the relevant discipline awarded by the Ministry of Youth Empowerment, Sports and Recreation or an equivalent qualification acceptable to the University of Mauritius.
- **C.** Swimming (lifeguard): Valid lifeguard certificate

Note:

In the absence of suitable qualified candidates, consideration may also be given to candidates having demonstrated abilities at National Competition in specific discipline together with documentary evidence of having read up to Form V.

Skills

Candidates should:

- have a good knowledge and up-to-date with his/her sports discipline;
- have good communication, listening and motivating skills;
- be able to inspire trust, discipline and positive attitudes;
- be able to deliver adequate training sessions with good demonstration, skills and apply respective strategies to improve performance;
- be learner-centered, innovative and good leader;
- be punctual;
- respect and adopt appropriate behaviors in all circumstances.

Responsibilities & Duties

- 1. To run training session/s in related sports discipline on UoM premises or any sports facilities.
- 2. To prepare students, at beginner or intermediate level, to acceptable sports performance.
- 3. To develop/improve and implement appropriate skills and techniques to meet tactical and strategical situation.
- 4. To monitor and assess student's performance in training or competition.
- 5. To prepare and coach UoM teams for intra and extra mural tournaments and activities.
- 6. To assist in the organization of his/her sports discipline as and when required by the UoM Sports Unit.
- 7. To provide assistance in tournaments, events and decisions at UoM as and when required.
- 8. To properly record attendance to training sessions and performance.
- 9. To abide by the general rules and regulations of the University of Mauritius and attend Sports Committee as and when required.
- 10. To perform such other duties directly related to the main duties above or related to the delivery of the output and results expected from Sports Coaches/Instructors in the roles ascribed to them.

Note:

Sports Coaches/Instructors may be required to work at staggered hours (including Saturdays, Sundays and public holidays as and when required), which will depend on the availability and number of students following courses.

Remuneration

- 1. Sports Coaches/Instructors will be remunerated *on a monthly basis* as follows:
 - Rs 3000/- **One session** per week
- 2. An allowance of Rs 350/- will be paid for any additional training session or required attendance to any event in the context of participation of UoM students/staff in Sports and Games events (Inter Tertiary, National or International Universities Sports Exchange)

Duration of Contract

The duration of the contract will be for the Academic Year 2022-2023. It may be renewable for the next Academic Year.
