Applications are invited from suitably qualified candidates for the post of **Research Assistants (Part-Time)** to work on the research project entitled "**Road Traffic Deaths and Injuries: The Shadow to GDP and Welfare in Mauritius – Part 2**", for a contractual period of **three (3) months**.

Qualifications Required

- Degree in Mathematics, Economics, Engineering, Finance or any equivalent qualification.

Profile

Candidates must have:

- Good research and communication skills
- Good analytical and scientific writing skills.
- Good econometric and statistical techniques for data analysis
- Prior experience in conducting and organizing national household surveys
- Adequate knowledge in the relevant field of Research.

Responsibilities & Duties

- Conducting a comprehensive literature review for this research;
- Collect and tabulate appropriate secondary data on the topic;
- Drafting of questionnaires for data collection
- Organise meetings, interviews and Focus Group Discussions;
- Draft the information obtained from the interviews, meetings and Focus Group Discussions;
- Organise and supervise fieldwork for data collection
- Collect, input and analyse data;
- Use statistical software for data analysis and interpretation;
- Report to the Principal Investigator and other team members; and
- Report and paper writing as well as presentation of obtained results.
- Any other tasks related to the project as identified by the supervisors.

Remuneration

A monthly basic allowance of Rs 13,700/-, plus salary compensation at approved rate, plus travelling expenses, based on bus fares

Duration of Contract

Appointment will be offered for an initial contractual period of **three (3) months**, renewable if required.
