Applications are invited from suitably qualified candidates for the post of **Research Assistant (Part-time)**, to work on the research project entitled "*OERQI – An Open Learning Platform for capacity-building in Youth Work based on the Micro-Credentials Concept*", for a contractual period of six (6) months.

Qualifications Required:

• A Degree in Computing/Education/Education Technology or any equivalent qualification.

Profile

Candidates must have:

- Research and communication skills;
- Analytical skills and adequate knowledge in the relevant field of Research;
- Experience in e-Learning development, and interactive materials;
- Experience in programming, software development and platform deployment; and
- Good analytical and problem-solving skills with adequate knowledge in the relevant fields of research.

Responsibilities & Duties

- (i) Assist in the elaboration of a badging/micro-credentials framework;
- (ii) Data Gathering & Report-writing;
- (iii) Development of interactive learning and video resources;
- (iv) Installation and customization of the proposed OERQI Learning Platform;
- (v) End-user training; and
