Applications are invited from suitably qualified candidates for the post of **Research Assistant (Full-Time)**, to work on a research project, funded by the Higher Education Commission (HEC), entitled "**Digestive Stability and Bioaccessibility of Locally Derived Nutraceuticals with Anti-Inflammatory and Gut Microbiota Modulating Properties**" at the Biopharmaceutical Unit of the Centre for Biomedical and Biomaterials Research (CBBR) for a contractual period of **twelve (12)** months.

Qualifications Required

- A degree in Biology, Biochemistry, Biotechnology, Food Science, Nutritional Sciences, Pharmacy or any other related field.
