Applications are invited from suitably qualified candidates for the post of **Research Assistants (Part-Time)** to work on the research project entitled *“Development of a Pedestrian Facility Audit Tool for Mauritius”*, for a contractual period of **four (4)** months.

### Qualifications Required

- Degree in Engineering or Degree in Mathematics or Degree in any other related field.

### Profile

Candidates must have:

- Good research and communication skills
- Good analytical and scientific writing skills.
- Good statistical techniques for data analysis
- Prior experience in conducting and organizing surveys

Preference will be given to candidates with knowledge in the field of research.

### Responsibilities & Duties

- Conducting a comprehensive literature review;
- Collect and tabulate appropriate secondary data on the topic;
- Drafting of questionnaires for data collection
- Organise meetings and interviews;
- Collect, input and analyse data using statistical software;
- Report writing and presentation of obtained results to stakeholders.
- Any other tasks related to the project as identified by the supervisors.

### Remuneration

A monthly all inclusive allowance of Rs 13,700/-, plus salary compensation at approved rate, plus travelling expenses, based on bus fares.

### Duration of Contract

Appointment will be offered for an initial contractual period of **four (4) months**, renewable if required. The proposed starting date will be **Monday 13 May 2024**.
