QUALIFICATIONS REQUIRED

Candidates should:

- 1. be a <u>Degree holder</u> in the above-listed field from a recognised institution or hold an equivalent qualification acceptable to the Board.
- 2. is an expert in the field with at least 5 years of relevant experience.

DUTIES OF INDUSTRY EXPERTS

- 1. Explain the workflow process and the production pipeline in the film industry
- 2. Expose student to the practical aspects of the film industry and the know-how to translate theories and concepts into practice
- 3. Enhance students' understanding of the various topics in the field
- 4. Relate their professional experiences to students with real-life examples of the workplace
- 5. Coach students for professional development
- 6. Demonstrate a highly skilled level of teaching and the ability to guide and assist other lecturers
- 7. Explain the expectations of the industry and workplace to students
- 8. Demonstrate expertise with the latest tools and software in their specialised field
- 9. Development of lecture and lab materials for class use.
- 10. To submit Module Catalogue at the beginning of the semester to all students and the Programme Coordinators;
- 11. To ensure that Learning Outcomes have been covered;
- 12. To set examination papers (main session or any other sessions), and hold Continuous Assessment
