- A degree in Mathematics with Computer Science and/or full-time MPhil/PhD students registered at the University of Mauritius.
- Successfully completed the module LLC0050 – Short Courses on Teaching Strategies and Administrative Responsibilities of Part-Time Lecturers.

Profile

Candidates must have:

- At least a second-class Bachelor's degree with Honours
- Excellent knowledge of Computational Science Topics (Floating Point Computations, Lagrange and Newton Interpolation, Simple Iterations for Nonlinear Equations)
- Excellent abilities in problem solving related to the above topics
- Good communication skills
- Good analytical and computational skills

Responsibilities & Duties

Under the direct supervision of the Module Lecturer/ Coordinator, the GTA will be responsible for:

- Running of tutorials on Undergraduate programmes of studies
- Counselling
- Assist in preparation/revision of module content and selection of text books and reading materials and preparation of instructional materials
- Invigilation of class tests and examinations
- Organisational and other cognate duties that may be assigned by the Dean of Faculty
