



Enlistment of Part-Time Sports Coach/Instructor

The University of Mauritius (UoM) as an Equal Opportunity Employer is inviting applications from suitably qualified candidates for appointment as Part-time Sports Coach/Instructor, for the following sports activities:

1. Gymnastics
2. Muay-Thai
3. Power Yoga
4. Table Tennis
5. Weight Training

Qualifications Required

- A. Cambridge School Certificate
- B. Level 1 of the specific part of the Brevet D'Etat de Cadre Sportif (BECS) in the relevant discipline awarded by the Ministry of Youth and Sports or an equivalent qualification acceptable to the University of Mauritius.

Note:

In the absence of suitable qualified candidates, consideration may also be given to candidates having demonstrated abilities at National Competition in specific discipline together with documentary evidence of having read up to Form V.

Skills

Candidates should:

- have a good communication skills;
- have the ability to inspire confidence and motivate participants;
- have a good professional, cultivating and positive attitude;
- a sensitive and supportive approach;
- strive to understand work transition, adjustment to work behavior, and respect of work environment.
- Have the ability to demonstrate skills and apply strategies to improve performance.

Responsibilities & Duties

1. To run training session/s in related sports discipline at the UoM.
2. To assist in the organization of his/her sports discipline as and when required by the UoM Sports Unit.
3. To provide assistance in Sports tournament at UoM as and when required.
4. To act as coach for UoM Sports team for intra and extra mural sports activities.
5. To act as assessor on athletes performance in training and competition.

6. To abide by the general rules and regulations of the University of Mauritius and attend Sports Committee as and when required.
7. To prepare students, both talented beginners and average level performers to an acceptable sports performance.
8. To develop and improve all basic skills and techniques in tactical and strategical situation which are apt to their physical and individual abilities.
9. To perform such other duties directly related to the main duties above or related to the delivery of the output and results expected from Coaches in the roles ascribed to them.

Note.

Sports Coaches will be required to work at staggered hours including Saturdays, Sundays and Public holidays as and when required.

Remuneration

Sports Coaches/Instructors will be remunerated Rs3000/- per month.

In case the UoM students/staff need to participate in some Sports and Games events (Inter Tertiary, national or International Universities Sports Exchange), the Sports Coaches/Instructors will be called to deliver additional training sessions and to be present during the staging of the event. The Sports Coaches/Instructors will be remunerated an amount of Rs350/- for each additional day.

Duration of Contract

The duration of the contract will be for the Academic Year 2024-2025. It may be renewable for the next Academic Year.
