### Qualifications Required:

- A first degree in BSc (Hons) Fisheries Science, or BSc (Hons) Aquaculture, or BSc (Hons) Marine Science and Technology, or BSc (Hons) Marine Environmental Sciences or any related degree to the field of the research project.

### Profile

Candidates must have:
