Applications are invited from suitably qualified candidates for two (2) posts of *Trainee Research Assistant* (Full-Time), to work on the research project entitled "*Marine litter monitoring in Mauritius, Rodrigues and Outer Islands*", for a contractual period of three (3) months.

Qualifications Required:

• A Bachelor's degree in Marine Environmental Sciences, Marine Science and Technology, Biology, Biological Sciences, or any other relevant field of science.

Profile

Candidates must have:

- Research and communication skills.
- Analytical skills and adequate knowledge in the relevant field of research.
- Ability to work in the field in the coastal zone.
- Swimming and snorkeling skills for field survey, as and when required.
- Competencies to carry out surveys, collect data and perform advanced statistical analysis using appropriate statistical tool(s).
- Previous experience and ability to work on the topic of marine litter and microplastics will be an advantage.
- Be available for travel, if needed.

Ability to work with any GIS software will be an advantage.

Responsibilities & Duties

- Carry out survey at study sites including beach, mangrove, estuary, islets, and rivers using standard protocols.
- Recording of data on survey sheets on site.
- Collection of samples from study sites and processing in the lab.
- Undertake characterization of macro, meso and micro marine litter.
- Conducting questionnaire surveys.
- Compilation of data, analysis of data, reporting results and writing reports.
- Assist in application of GIS tools to map sources, sinks and pathways of marine litter.
- Any other cognate duties.

Remuneration
