The University of Mauritius, as an equal opportunity employer, is inviting applications from suitably qualified candidates to signify their interest for enlistment as **Psychologist (Clinical)**:

QUALIFICATIONS: Candidates should possess a Master's Degree in Clinical Psychology or Counselling Psychology or Psychology from a recognised institution or an equivalent qualification acceptable to the University of Mauritius.

Candidates should have at least three (3) years' experience in the relevant field either in a recognised health or educational institution or as a private practitioner.

Candidates should possess a Business Registration Number, which should be provided to the University of Mauritius, in case they are selected.

Note:

Candidates should produce written evidence of knowledge and experience claimed.

Candidates should possess interpersonal and communication skills

DUTIES:

1. To support a safe learning environment and work to safeguard the human rights of all staff and students.
2. To offer staff and students a first point of contact to express their concerns regarding professional, personal, financial, social or practical issues and to refer matters to higher administrative levels where necessary.
3. To assess the therapeutic needs of staff and students and to provide psychotherapy and counselling accordingly.
4. To provide treatment services namely psychotherapy and counselling to perpetrators.
5. To make referral, where appropriate, for admission to hospital for psychiatric treatment in consultation with University Management.
6. To conduct individual/group therapy as and when required.
7. To take an active role in advising staff and students.
8. To conduct mass counselling sessions and conduct talks/sensitisation programmes as and when required.
9. To train, as and when required, staff dealing with students having psychological problems.
10. To provide psychological assessment and treatment services to staff and students of the University of Mauritius.

11. To prepare reports for the University Management, as and when required.
12. To form part of the Medical Board of the University, as and when required.
13. To perform other duties directly related to the main duties listed above or related to the delivery of the output and results expected from Psychologists (Clinical) in the roles ascribed to them.

Note:

Candidates may be required to work outside normal working hours including Saturdays.

REMUNERATION: Candidates will be remunerated on the basis of the number of sessions conducted, as per below:

- (i) Rs1000/-, for assessment of staff/student on a sessional basis of one (1) hour.
- (ii) Rs1500/-, for conducting talks and training.
- (iii) Rs2000/-, per sitting at the Medical Board.

CONDITION: The contract will be for an initial period of **one (1)** year, renewable.
