7. Assessment

Each module will be assessed over 100 marks with details as follows (unless otherwise specified):

Written examinations for all modules will be carried out at the end of the academic year except for semester modules (unless otherwise stated).

Assessment will be based on a written examination of 2 to 3 - hour duration (normally a paper of 2 hour duration for modules carrying less or equal to three credits, and 3 hour paper for modules carrying six credits) and on continuous assessment done during the semester or year.

Continuous Assessment will be based on a written class test and assignments / or oral presentations. The continuous assessment will count for 30% of the overall percentage mark of the module(s), except for a Programme where the structure makes for other specific provision(s).

Modules marked with an (R) are research-based modules will be assessed by a research project consisting of 40% of the total mark and 60% by examination.

An overall total of 40% for combined continuous assessment and written examination components would be required to pass the module, without minimum thresholds within the individual continuous assessment and written examination.

8. Disciplinary Specialisation in Dissertation / Research Project

Students have the choice of doing their dissertation / research project in either History <u>or</u> Sociology, <u>or</u> using Interdisciplinary research methods.

9. Submission Deadline for Dissertation / Research Project

Three copies of the dissertation / research project (two spiral-bound copies and one soft copy in a single PDF text file on electronic storage media) should be submitted to the Faculty/Centre Registry and in addition, a soft copy of the dissertation / research project in a single PDF text file should be uploaded on the "'*Turnitin' Platform*", in the final assignment submission link indicated by the Programme/Project Coordinator.

All of the above should be submitted not later than the last working day (i.e. excluding Saturdays, Sundays and Public Holidays) of March of the academic year by 4.00 p.m. at latest.
